

Learning Disability Partnership Board

Merton's Learning Disability Partnership Board shapes the direction of services for people with a learning disability in Merton. It was set up in October 2001 as Merton's first step towards implementing *Valuing People*, the Government white paper on learning disabilities.

The board is co-chaired by the Cabinet member for Adult Social Care and a social care customer, and represents the interests of many stakeholders. It includes carers and services users, social services, health and voluntary sector organisations.

The Partnership Board meets at 10am on the second Tuesday of the month at the High Path Community Resource Centre in Wimbledon.

The meeting is open to anyone who is interested in services for people with a learning disability.
